Mayor Pederson called the Special Meeting to order at approximately 9:01 am.

Mayor Pederson declared that the purpose of the meeting was canvassing results of the November 3, 2020 general election and read the results from the Pine City Abstract of Votes Cast and the council members validated the results on the canvassing worksheet.

Mayoral counts: Carl Pederson 1261 votes, Write-in 52 votes.

Council member counts: Kyle Palmer 642 votes; Ariel Dunbar 473 votes; Brian Scholin 438 votes; Steven Ovick 810 votes; Write-in 22 votes.

There were 1725 persons registered as of 7:00 am and 198 persons registered on Election Day. The total number of persons that voted was 1618 (representing 84%).

Van Steenwyk provided a summary of the in-person vs absentee voting. An inquiry was made on the write in tally sheets detail. Van Steenwyk noted that he would seek clarification from the County and relay that information.

Motion made by Sloan, second by Scholin to approve the results of the general election per the Abstract of Votes. Motion passed by roll call vote with Pederson, Sloan, Scholin, and Ovick in favor and none against.
