



Emergency City Council Meeting Minutes

In attendance: Mayor Carl Pederson (via phone), Councilor Steve Ovick, Councilor Brian Scholin, Councilor Mary Kay Sloan, and Councilor Gina Pettie (via phone).

Absent: None.

Staff in attendance: City Administrator Matthew Van Steenwyk and Community Development Director Lezlie Sauter (via phone).

Acting Mayor Scholin called the meeting to order at approximately 2:30 pm and led the Council in the Pledge of Allegiance.

Resolution 20-29 – Declaring a Local Emergency – Councilor Scholin read Resolution 20-29 aloud. *Pederson made a motion, seconded by Pettie, to adopt resolution 20-29, Declaring a Local Emergency. On a rollcall vote, the motion passed 5-0, with Pederson, Scholin, Ovick, Pettie, and Sloan voting in favor, and none voting against.*

Van Steenwyk requested direction consider placing a moratorium on door-to-door transient merchants and solicitor permits. Council indicated support of such a change for safety purposes.

A discussion was had on the impacts of this resolution. It was noted that it primarily provided for audio and video meetings for Council and subcommittees. Van Steenwyk made note that it provides for some potential changes to ordinances and permits with regard to public safety.

Scholin adjourned the meeting at approximately 2:47 pm.
