Minimum liability insurance coverage must be \$2,000,000** The City is not responsible for any injury or property damage attributed to the placement of furniture or the consumption of intoxicating liquors/beer on the sidewalk.
- A scale drawing of the sidewalk seating/serving site plan layout for tables, fencing, parking etc. that demonstrates compliance with the following standards:
 1. Outdoor furniture is in good condition and movable
 2. Placement of furniture must remain in front of the building's façade and not encroach in front of adjoining businesses or prevent safe entrance or outlet into the business or adjoining businesses
 3. Area must be clearly marked by a physical barrier
 4. Outdoor furniture must have a minimum of 3ft unencumbered pedestrian aisle between furniture and other sidewalk features (curb, tree grates, planters, utility poles, traffic/street signs, street lights, etc.)

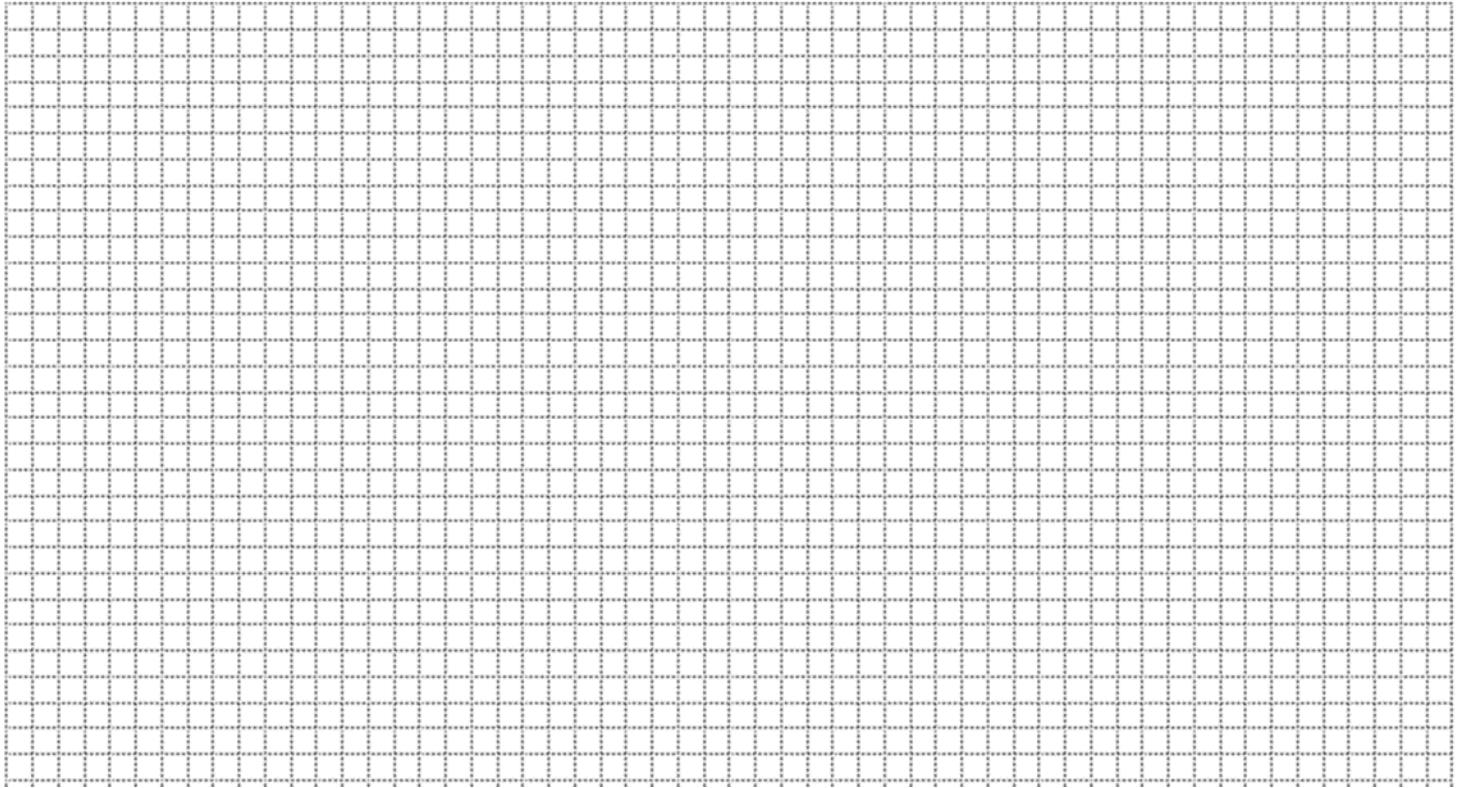

Additional Information from the City of Pine City Code of Ordinances

Chapter 8, Section 820: Street & Sidewalk Obstructions (summarized)

Al Fresco Dining:

- The City may issue an Al Fresco Dining license to a restaurant or other food service business located within the Central Business District (CBD) to allow the placement of tables and/or chairs in the public sidewalk or extension where approved.
- Outdoor furniture is allowed on the public sidewalk May 1st to October 31st of a calendar year.
- Accumulation of garbage or unclean conditions in the outdoor area as well as violations, nuisance complaints or code enforcement issues with outdoor furniture on the sidewalk may be basis for revocation of the license.
- Service and food consumption on the public sidewalk shall be limited from 8am – 10pm.

Chapter 6, Section 600: Intoxicating Liquor Licensing (summarized)

Al Fresco Liquor License:

- The City may issue an Al Fresco Liquor License to a restaurant or bar authorizing the sale and consumption of intoxicating liquors within a defined outdoor serving area located on the sidewalk or on-street parking stall.
- The outdoor serving area must be physically separated from non-serving areas in a manner that clearly defines the boundaries of the outdoor serving area. Outdoor furniture is allowed on the public sidewalk May 1st to October 31st of a calendar year.
- Service and consumption under this license shall be limited from 8am – 10pm.

Al Fresco Beer License:

- The City may issue an Al Fresco Beer License to a restaurant, bar or brewery tap room authorizing the sale and consumption of beer and/or 3.2% malt liquor within a defined outdoor serving area located on the sidewalk or on-street parking stall.
- The outdoor serving area must be physically separated from non-serving areas in a manner that clearly defines the boundaries of the outdoor serving area. Outdoor furniture is allowed on the public sidewalk May 1st to October 31st of a calendar year.
- Service and consumption under this license shall be limited from 8am – 10pm.
