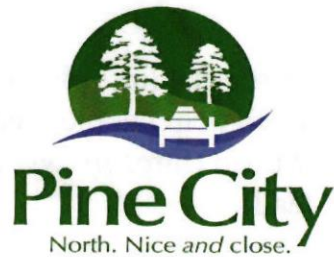

Notice to Individuals Served by a Service Line of Unknown Material

City of Pine City is focused on protecting the health of every household in our community. This notice contains important information about your drinking water. Please share this information with anyone who drinks and/or cooks using water at this property. In addition to people directly served at this property, this can include people in apartments, nursing homes, schools, businesses, as well as parents served by childcare at this property.

City of Pine City is working to identify service line materials throughout the water system and has determined that as of August 28, 2024, a portion of or the entire water pipe (called a service line) that connects your home, building, or other structure to the water main is made from unknown material but may be lead. In some cases, a portion of the service line may have been identified as non-lead, but it is still classified as unknown until the entire length of the service line has been identified. Because your service line material is unknown, there is the potential that some or all of the service line could be made of lead or galvanized pipe that was previously connected to lead. People living in homes with a lead or galvanized pipe previously connected to a lead service line have an increased risk of exposure to lead from their drinking water.
