EXTRACTS FROM THE MINUTES OF A
REGULAR MEETING OF THE VILLAGE
COUNCIL OF Pine City,
MINNESOTA

On the 29 day of Sept, 1966, the Village Council
of Pine City, Minnesota, met in regular session at the
Council Room in Pine City, Minnesota. The meeting
was called to order at 7:30 o'clock P.M. by Mayor Lowell
and on the roll call the following members were found to be
present, constituting a quorum:

Messrs: Arund, Halstein, Hegseth, Christiansen, Sellock

Absent: None.

The clerk reported that pursuant to a resolution adopted
by the Village Council on the 7th day of June,
1966, the notice directed to be published in the Pine Lake
Advertiser was published in that newspaper on June 23 & 25,
1966. The clerk submitted proof of publication of said
notice, which was ordered filed.

Pursuant to the notice, a full opportunity to be heard
on the questions set forth therein was granted to all residents
of Pine City, Minnesota, and its environs and to all other
interested persons; witnesses and evidence were examined and
testimony was heard.

At the conclusion of the hearing, the following resolution
was introduced by Councilman Halstein, who moved its
adoption.

RESOLUTION NO. _____

A RESOLUTION DECLARING THE NEED FOR A HOUSING AND REDEVELOPMENT
AUTHORITY IN Pine City, MINNESOTA

Pursuant to Resolution No. _____ adopted by this body on
the 7th day of June, 1966, a hearing has been held
by the Village Council at Pine City, Minnesota, to
determine the need for a Housing and Redevelopment Authority
to function in such Village.

Whereas, facts have been submitted to this body showing
that there is a need for a Housing and Redevelopment Authority
to function in the Village of Pine City, Minnesota:

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE Village COUNCIL OF
THE Village of Pine City, MINNESOTA.

That the Village Council of Pine City, Minnesota
pursuant to the "Municipal Housing and Redevelopment Act" of
the State of Minnesota, hereby finds, determines and declares:

1. There exists in Pine City, Minnesota,
substandard or blighted areas which cannot be redeveloped
without the assistance of government;
2. Adequate housing accommodations are not available
to veterans and servicemen and their families;
3. There is a shortage of decent, safe, and sanitary
dwelling accommodations available to persons of low income and
their families at rentals they can afford;
4. It is hereby declared that there is a need for a
Housing and Redevelopment Authority to function in Pine City
Minnesota, and said need continues to exist.

The motion to adopt such resolution was seconded by
Councilman Venuntzen, and upon roll call the following
voted:

Thereupon the Mayor declared said resolution duly adopted
and passed.
